

Checklist for your dogs first-aid kit



- First aid kit (disinfectant, ointment, scissors, bandages, disposable gloves)
- Thermometer
- Tweezers
- Traumeel ad us. vet.
- Remedies for diarrhea (e.g. probiotics)
- Tick tweezers
- Parasite protection (according to the region)
- Nurexan ad us. vet.
- Medication: sufficient quantity of medication that your dog may need to take regularly
- Eye rinsing solution for cleaning the eyes and small wounds
- Cream for the care of chapped, irritated skin or for superficial wounds, e.g. on the paws (e.g. Ichtho Vet Derma Cream)



Of course, even the best first-aid kit cannot solve every health problem: If the dog is ill or has a more serious injury, a visit to the vet is mandatory, even on vacation. You should therefore carry a list of addresses and telephone numbers of veterinary clinics and vets at your vacation destination with you or, ideally, save the numbers in your cell phone at home.
